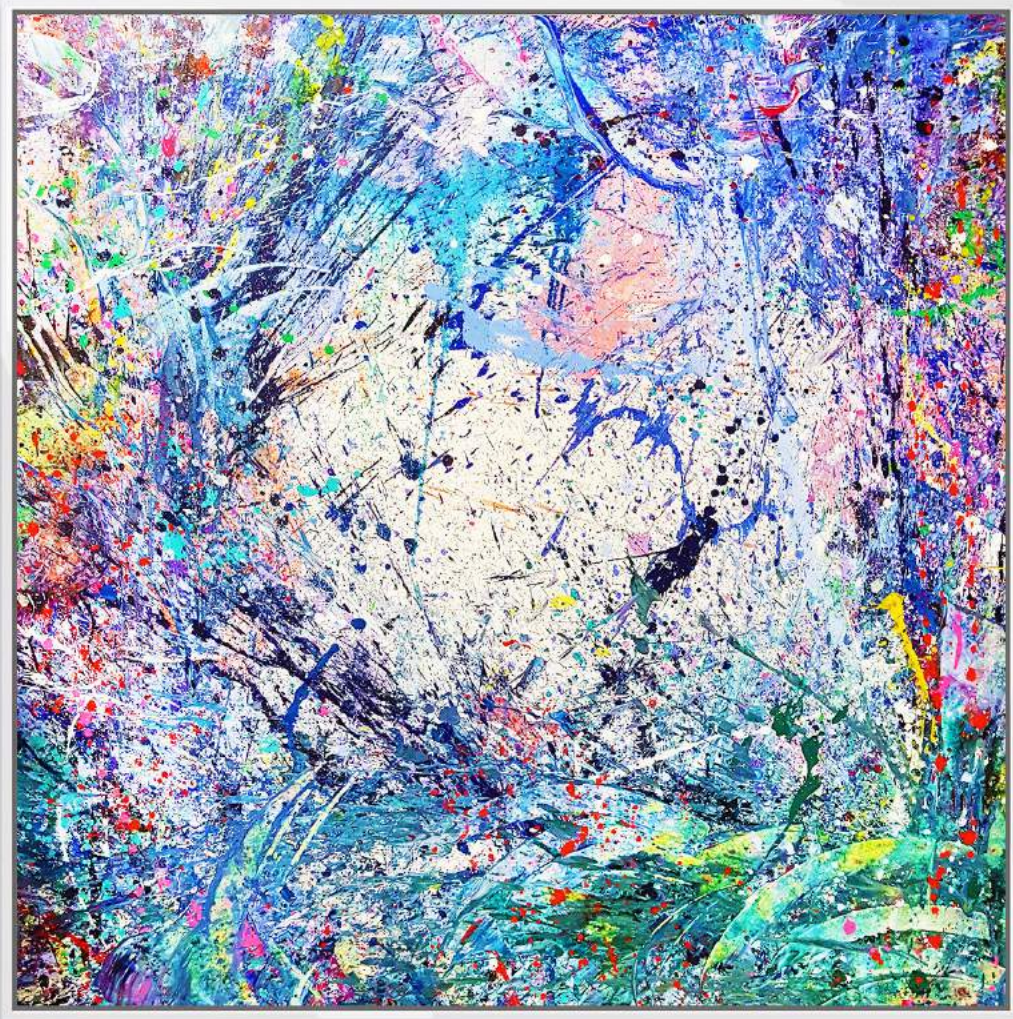

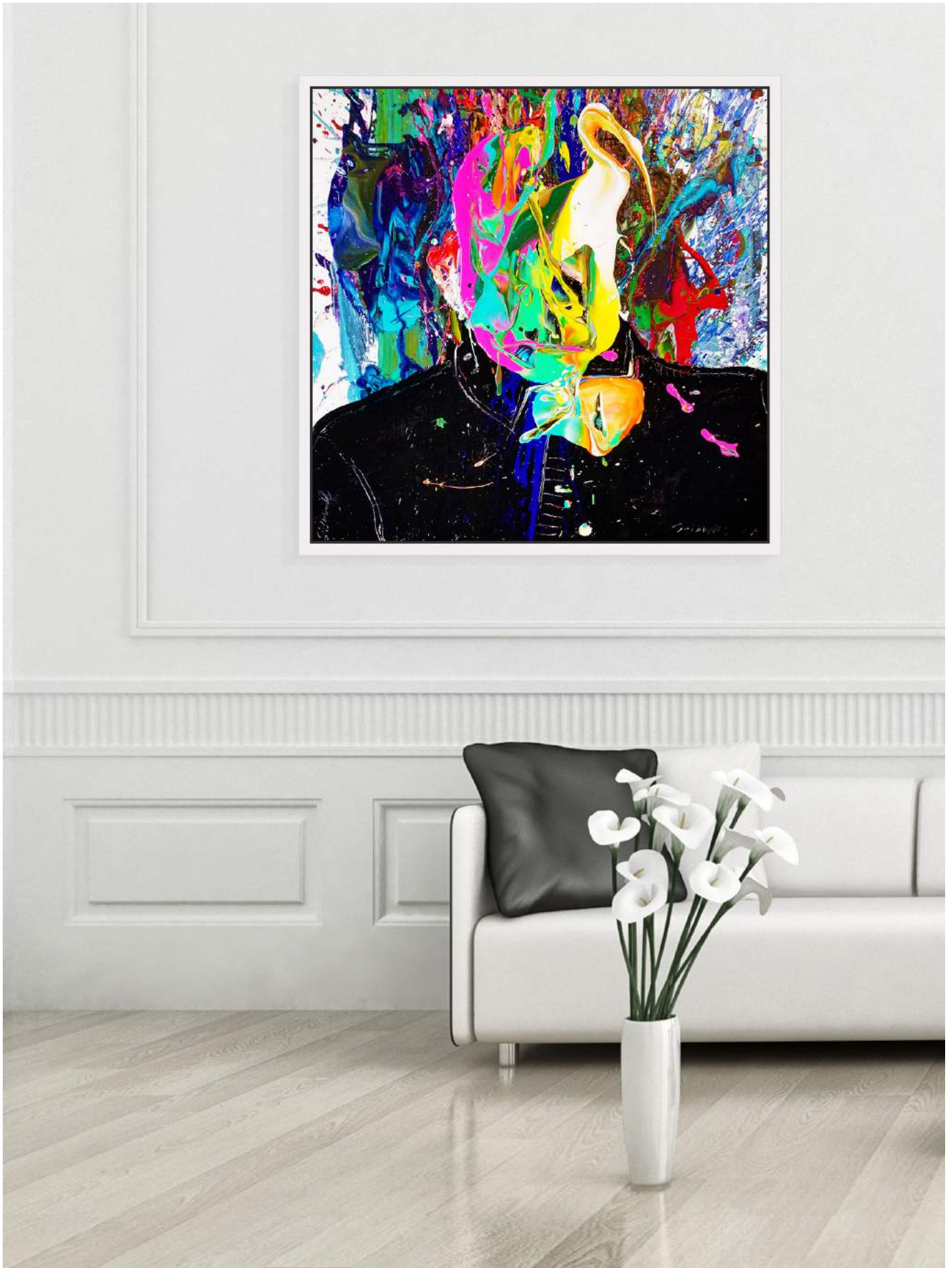

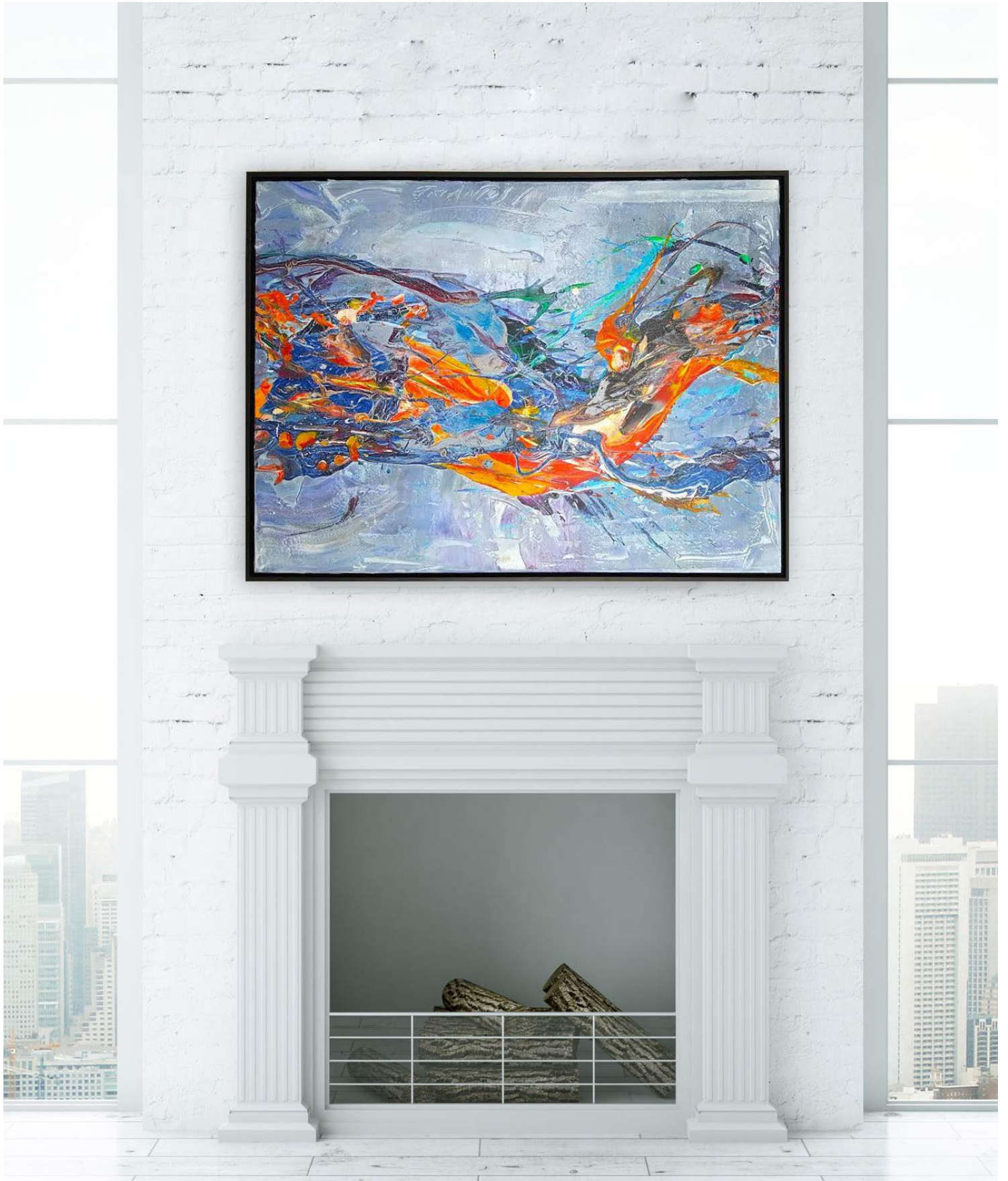

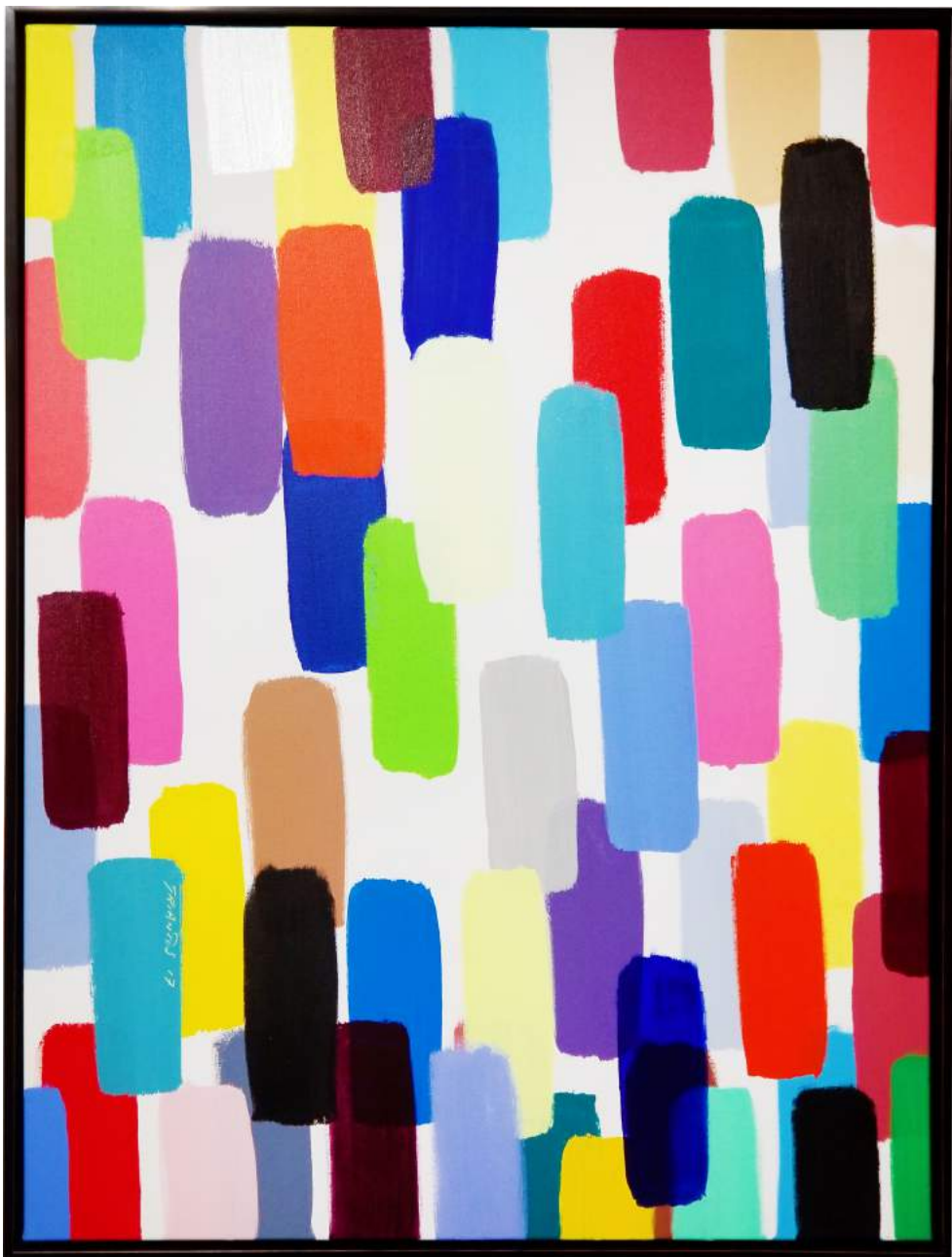
Brain Matters Donation

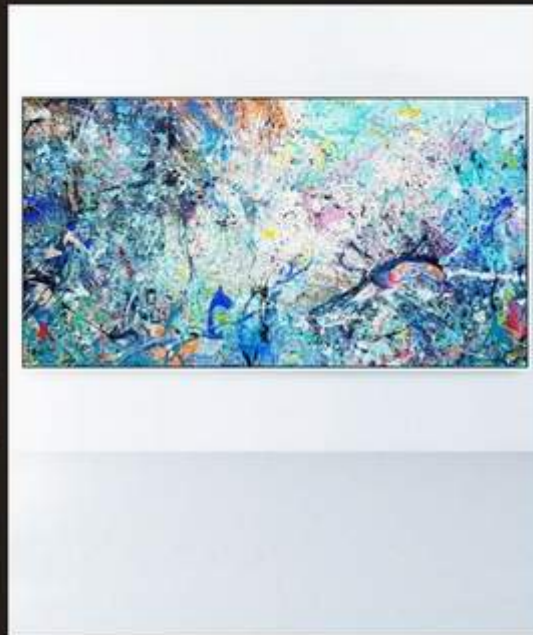
